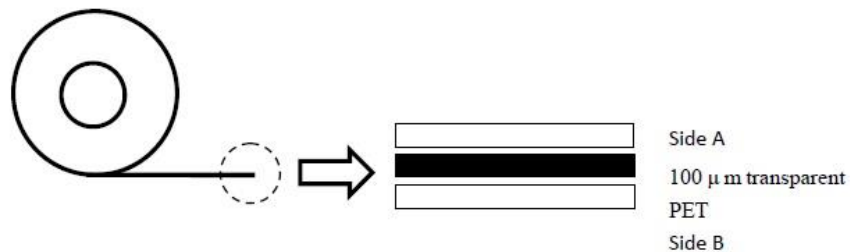


D262-100L1D Release Film

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

D262-100L1D is a transparent release film composed of one layer of PET-Film coated on both sides with silicone oil. It shows good evenness, low peel strength and remains clean in fabrication, making it suitable for using in clean environment. It is widely used as an anti-sticking base material.



Side B is facing outwards.
